d) Tom tries to explain to St Clare what freedom means.

e) Tom says he will stay with St Clare as long as he is troubled.

Ophelia and Topsy: a) Ophelia wants St Clare to put in writing that Topsy belongs to her.

b) Ophelia is in a hurry because she is afraid St Clare is in debt.

c) Ophelia thinks it is wrong to teach a slave to be a Christian.(5.52)
